

## Champion Students' Achievement on State Report Card among Top 7%

Champion School students' performance on last year's state testing ranked in the top 7% of 614 Ohio school districts. Also, they were the only students in Trumbull, Columbiana, Mahoning or Portage counties to pass all 30 state indicators on last year's State Report Card. The 30 indicators assess student achievement in grades 3-10, as well as student attendance and graduation rate.

Champion students have earned the distinction of achieving all 30 indicators for 2 consecutive years.
