

## WAYS TO VOLUNTEER AT CENTRAL ELEMENTARY

- **Character Education Council**

Time commitment: 1 day per month Sept -May  
Your task: teach a prepared character education lesson in grades K-4  
Volunteers Needed: about 20  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. DiChristofaro, guidance counselor

- **Junior Achievement**

Time commitment: 1 day per month -Jan -6 consecutive weeks  
Your task: teach a prepared economics lesson grades K-4  
Volunteers Needed: about 20  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. DiChristofaro, guidance counselor

- **Reading Tutors** \* Must have current BCI/FBI check

Time commitment: 1 hour / 1 day a week Sept - April  
Your task: helping student(s) with reading  
Volunteers Needed: more than we ever have  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. Kirk, Principal

- **Copier assistance for Teachers**

Time commitment: 2 hours per day each week  
Tues for 2 hours etc Sept - May  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. Anderson, Central Secretary

- **Special Event Volunteers**

Time commitment: usually part of a day  
Example of events: Picture Day (1 day in October) or Kindergarten Screening (2 days in April) or Orientation days for students- 1-3 times a year  
Your task: provide extra helping hands  
Volunteers Needed: more than we ever have  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. Anderson, Central secretary

- **Health Screenings** (vision, hearing, scalp checks)

Time commitment: usually part of a couple days a year  
Example of events: hearing checks, vision checks and or scalp checks (beauticians and hairstylists welcome)  
Your task: assist the school nurse in these checks  
Volunteers Needed: 1 dozen or as determined by the nurse  
Who to see if interested: Mrs. Bucco, Central nurse
