

Bullying Procedures for Champion Schools

June 1, 2011

- All referrals are investigated by administrators
- Referrals are made by: parents, students, teachers, principal, asst. principal, support staff, and bully hotline
- Investigation completed by administrators
- Bully and victim meet separately with guidance
- Guidance monitors both bully and victim with documentation
- Parents notified and the action taken.
- Teachers notified of potential bullying
- Education and awareness by: announcements made by principal, assemblies, character education, small group activities and individuals as needed
- All teachers and support staff has a copy of the procedures
- Bully hotline signs posted throughout out building
- Bullying definition posted in all classes and throughout building

Bullying, Harassment Intimidation Definition

- Something done on purpose
 - Something that happens more than once
 - Something that is hurtful to others
- Examples: name calling, hitting, using verbal taunts, spreading rumors, taking someone's things, making fun of people, embarrassing people, laughing at someone, shoving, putting people down, threatening anyone, harassing someone, and picking on or attacking people because they are different in some way i.e. race, religion, gender, family background, etc
