Trumbull County Scholarships – There are five scholarships available (see below). One application may be used for all five. **Deadline: Mar. 9, 2012.**

- **First Place Bank of Warren Paul A Watson Scholarship-** Graduating seniors must demonstrate their superior performance and commitment to school and community involvement. Selection will be based upon school and community involvement. Must have at least a 3.0 GPA.
- **Marae Ohl Scholarship-** Ten scholarships are available. Financial need is a factor. These \$1,000 scholarships are for one year only.
- **Rotary Club of Warren** - Applicants must have a verified learning or physical disability and show financial need. \$1,000.
- **Stanley L. and Grace A. Woofter Scholarship** - Two \$1,500 scholarships will be awarded for one year. This scholarship may be renewable. Applicant must have a verified learning or physical disability, demonstrated scholarship achievement, participation in activities and financial need.
- **Trumbull County Scholarship-** Several non-renewable scholarships are available. Preference will be given to deserving students of the Trumbull County Children's Services first, and then to students demonstrating scholarship and participation in activities. Awards were \$500 last year.

Christie W. Manchester Memorial Scholarship – One \$1,000 scholarship to a graduating senior who plans to pursue a degree from a college, university, trade school or military academy. Scholarship based upon financial need, school activities, GPA, school activities, award/ recognitions, character/integrity, work history and class rank.
