BULLYING - Central Elementary School:

BULLYING - Champion Middle School:

- **Character lessons** assigned to students in detention/Sat. School
- **Anti Cyber-Bullying Lessons** via computer classes

BULLYING—Champion High School:

- **Annual Assembly** on prevention of bullying and on safe use of technology and social media

STUDENT LEADERSHIP—Middle School and High School

- **CHS and CMS Leadership Development**—Student Advisory groups at CMS and CHS help shape leadership skills as students advise administrators on curriculum, school climate, safety, scheduling, even meal options in the cafeterias.

SOCIAL AND EMOTIONAL SUPPORT

- **Support services** via school counselors
- **PAX Behavioral System** at CES
- Services provided to students through **Trumbull Student Assistance Consortium (TSAC)**
- **“Homes for Kids”** social worker services for students in need
- **CES: Character Counts**
- **CMS: School Counselor Lunchroom “Network” Program**
- **CHS: Student-led Support Initiatives**

STUDENT SAFETY:

- **Suicide Prevention Initiatives:** All buildings conduct an annual assembly focusing on ways students can seek help for concerns.
- Administrators, upon becoming aware of a suicide threat, call the parent, hold the student until parent arrives, and provide information on professional agencies to parent.
- **Safety Town:** This program is available to incoming Kindergartners pending enrollment limits. Parents are encouraged to enroll students in this summer program.
- **Safety and Violence Prevention Training** for staff as mandated by the Ohio Department of Education (ODE) every 5 years
- **Annual State-Required Drills** for weather emergencies, fire, evacuation, and intruder.
- **Referrals to School Nurses and School Counselors** on student safety, suspected abuse.
- Instruction on **dating violence, drug/alcohol abuse, and suicide prevention.**
- **Bolo sticks** used in CHS for classroom door security
- **Intercom systems** K-12 for two-way communication for classrooms to office.
- **Resource Officer** on campus
- **Suicide prevention training** as mandated by ODE every 2 years.

DRUG, ALCOHOL, AND SMOKING PREVENTION

- All buildings conduct **Red Ribbon Week** activities
- **CMS Pledge** “The Best Me is Drug and Alcohol Free”
- **Anti-Drug and Smoking Prevention curriculum** conducted in health classes (CMS/CHS)
- **CHS students deliver** anti-drug, alcohol and smoking prevention “talks” to CES
- **Alcohol testing** for CHS students prior to admittance to Homecoming and Prom
- **CHS athletes complete baseline drug testing** during sports season
- **Random drug/alcohol testing** for CHS students who purchase a parking pass, participate in sports or extracurricular activities
- **SMASH Program** (Students Making A Safer Highway) students present two programs a year with messages to deter distracted and/or intoxicated driving
