Student Council is a group of student leaders representing Champion Middle School. The organization consists of students with strong leadership and academic skills. Student Council members must also demonstrate strong character. The group organizes fundraising, community outreach programs, and various activities for the CMS student body. Students interested in joining Student Council must commit to becoming a leader at CMS. This year will be different than previous years. We will do most of our communicating using Google Classroom and/or Zoom. There are 2 parts to applying for Student Council: the application and a project.

Part 1: Application: Fill out the application and review the expectations. You are expected to participate in all events listed and “attend” all meetings. Your parent/guardian must also sign the application.

Part 2: Project: Building Champion Pride Art Work:

- Create a piece of artwork for the CMS display case that demonstrates your Champion Pride. Your art can be paper or 3D, the more creative the better! It must fit inside the display case, so the maximum height allowed is 16 inches and maximum width 24 inches. Other than the size restriction, there are no limits to your creativity. You could make a poster, a drawing, painting, shirt, sculpture, 3D object, scrapbook, etc...Your art just needs to show your pride in our school and/or community.
- Write 1-2 paragraphs explaining:
 - What does Champion Pride mean to you?
 - Explain your artwork
 - What does it represent? Why did you create it? How does it show Champion Pride?
