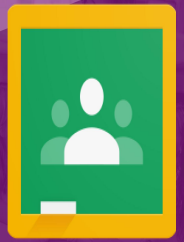
# Online Model

LA & SS:  
Tues/Thurs

Math & Sci:  
Wed/Fri

- 100% all online model for the first semester has the curriculum and instruction provided by all CMS teachers.
- Students will attend online classes through Zoom for Language Arts & Social Studies on Tuesdays & Thursdays and **Math & Science on Wednesdays & Fridays.**
- Students will be provided work through Google Classroom for the other three (3) days of those classes online.
- All CMS teachers will be available to students on Zoom on Mondays from 8:00-9:00am to provide extra help, answer questions, make clarifications, etc.
- Students will follow their schedule of classes as to when to Zoom online for LA, SS, M & SC.
- Students will not have classes in Band/Choir, Art, Phys. Ed/Health, or STEM
- Students are eligible to participate in CMS sports and extracurricular activities
- If Champion Local switches to an ALL ONLINE learning model due to Covid-19, everything will remain the same with the students currently in the remote model.

# ONLINE PLATFORM FOR REMOTE MODEL



- At CMS, all teachers will use Google Classroom as their platform for teaching for the 2020-2021 school year.
- Within the classroom, teachers can post links to other platforms such as Edulastic, Discovery Techbooks, Jefferson City Virtual Learning, Quizlet, Khan Academy, etc.
- Parents will have access to Google Classroom as well to see what assignments were posted, including due dates.
- Google Classroom will be used in the 100% online remote model, as well as the hybrid model.

# Example of a 1st Semester Online Schedule

LA & SS: Tuesday and Thursday

Math & Science: Wednesday and Friday

Students will resume online learning while not in the classroom for three (3) days each week

Students are required to be online during their scheduled class periods for LA, SS, Math & Science

Example of a student's schedule:

1st PERIOD Social Studies: 8:00 - 8:45

3rd PERIOD Math: 8:47 - 9:56

5th PERIOD Language Arts: 11:38 - 12:47

6th PERIOD Science: 12:25 - 1:10



# Getting Started Online Model

- Students will be issued a Chromebook with case and charger (Chromebook pick-up: Monday, August 31st from 5:00-7:00pm through Door 14)
- Internet hotspots are available upon request
- Students will receive a schedule of classes with teachers' names and scheduled class times- Tuesday/Thursday: LA & SS, Wednesday/Friday: Math & Science
- CMS Zoom Online Orientation: Monday, August 31st at 7:15pm
- Tuesday, September 1st, students will be notified by their teachers how to get started in their classes through their championlocal.org emails: Google Classroom invites and Zoom class links.
- Thursday, September 3rd is the first day of classes for Language Arts and Social Studies and students are expected to log into Zoom classes on time according to their schedules.
- Friday, September 4th is the first day of classes for Math and Science and students are expected to log into Zoom classes on time according to their schedules..

# Student Etiquette While Online

- ALL CMS Code of Conduct rules apply
- Students will be Zooming in on time for every class
- Students will use their real first and last names
- Students will be kind and respectful at all times
- Students will be prepared for class
- Students will be in a quiet area free of distractions
- Students will stay in one spot during class
- Students will keep their video on at all times
- Students will maintain eye contact with the teacher/speaker
- Students will mute their microphones when not speaking
- Students will raise their hands and wait to be called upon by the teacher
- Students will wear school appropriate clothing
- Students will not eat or chew gum during classes
- Students will not be distracting with their words or actions

# GRADING PROCEDURES

- For the 2020-2021 school year, Champion Local Schools will be using the Board Adopted grading policy.
- This differs from the 2020 4th quarter, which was Pass/Fail.
- Our grading will remain consistent in all three potential models: Full In-Person Model, Hybrid Model, and Full Online Model.
- Students will receive instruction in Language Arts, Math, Social Studies and Science.
- Students will not receive instruction in STEM, Art, Physical Education/Health or Music.
- Students are able to participate in extracurricular activities and sports.
- If you wish to change your educational model from online to in-person, you will be eligible for review after the 1st semester.



# STUDENT ATTENDANCE



- Teachers will take normal attendance during Zoom class time.
- During three days of remote learning, teachers will focus on evidence of student presence and engagement that may include, but not limited to:
  - Daily Google Classroom Logins, Posting on Google Classroom, Completing tasks on Google Classroom.
  - Attending Zoom platform sessions.
  - Appropriate progression through learning and assignment completion.
- If a student is absent due to Covid-19 exposure or positive case, their absence(s) will not be counted against them.



# STUDENTS RECEIVING SPECIAL SERVICES

- Any student that has opted into school at Champion Local Schools for this year will still have full access to special services. (Champion full, hybrid, or remote models). This does not apply to TVLA, ACE, or other outside service platforms.
- This includes all support services listed on a student's IEP, 504, Behavior Plans, Counseling (CMS, Cadence Care, Psychologists).



# SOCIAL & EMOTIONAL SUPPORTS

- Focused attention on social emotional learning, health, digital wellness and digital citizenship.
- Town halls to keep the community connected.
- We encourage staff, students and families to talk with people they trust about their concerns about COVID-19 and how they are feeling.
- We conduct ongoing regular training among all staff on updated health and safety protocols.
- Partnering with the Trumbull County Board of Health to stay updated with the newest information as it is related to Covid-19 and other health concerns.
- We have one school counselor and one social worker available for educational and Social-Emotional Learning needs.
- We have partnered with Cadence Care again this year to provide SEL counseling for our students who are interested. These services will be available in person and remotely to accomodate all of our students.

# CHROMEBOOK & INTERNET POLICY

Students are still expected to follow the Acceptable Use Policy for technology when they are remote learning. The Code of Conduct extends to remote learning at home with regards to internet usage, not limited to:

- E-mail sent to harm, harass, or threaten another individual
- Obscene gestures/words/music on learning platforms (Google Classroom/Zoom/etc.).
- Pornography-Mail Fraud-Transmission of programs containing viruses
- Physical damage of a computer hard drive and/or desktop
- Plagiarism



# VISITOR PROTOCOLS

- No visitors will be permitted into the middle school.
- IEP and other parent meetings will be virtual, unless otherwise specified. These will be by appointment ONLY.
- FYI: Parents/Guardians picking up students during the school day will arrive at the CMS main entrance and ring the buzzer. They will state who they are there to pick up and the reason. They will show their I.D. to the camera. Once verified, they will wait outside for their child.
- No face to face meetings will occur unless deemed necessary. They will be by appointment only. No one will be allowed to enter the building without an appointment.
